DESCRIPTION:

Artistic, historic and commercial lithographs arranged in chronological order to show the development of lithographic printing in Germany, France, Great Britain and the United States. The collection, acquired by the Fuchs & Lang Manufacturing Co., is comprised of examples of the work of every major nineteenth-century lithographer and lithographic printer, including Senefelder, Hullmandel, Lemercier and Currier & Ives. The lithographs are arranged according to the numbers in the catalogs published by the company (see below); this chronological sequence is supplemented by indexes to the lithographers and lithographic printers. Unidentified prints are arranged at the end of the collection by country, printer or publisher.
