**DESCRIPTION:** This collection is in two parts, the first of which is housed in the Department of Special Collections, and the second of which is housed in the Avery Architectural Library.

Part I. - contains about 140 literary and political papers and documents relating to Venice and Venetian families from the 15th through the 18th centuries. The material includes a group of the Busenello family papers which are largely wills, transfers of property, laudatory verses, and Latin prose (related to Dr. Livingston's La Vita Veneziana nelle opere di Gian Francesco Busenello, Venice, 1913); a series of moral and political sonnets in the Venetian dialect by Angelo Mario Labia (1790-1775); and a number of other documents and papers related to the Viscordi family and the Venetian state.

Part II - consists of a group of about 40 manuscript items dealing with buildings and real estate in and around Venice in the 16th, 17th, and 18th centuries. The material consists of documents relating to the properties in the neighborhood of Padua belonging to the school of Pan Rocco in Venice, papers and plans relating to the properties and papace of the Tusenello family, and drawings by Pietro Tamballi. In both Part I and Part II of the collection the material is entirely in manuscript and is in Italian and Latin.
