Prof. Lorwin's papers deal with his professional life from 1908 until 1970 (see verso for a chronology of his career). Among the correspondents are: Louis D. Brandeis, Felix Frankfurter, Ben W. Huebsch, Paul U. Kellogg, Harold J. Laski, Frances Perkins, and Gifford Pinchot.

1925-35	On the staff of the Brookings Institution
1929-39	Member of the Institute of Pacific Relations
1935-39	Economic advisor to the International Labor Office, Geneva
1939-43	Consultant with the Temporary National Economic Commission, National Resources Planning Board and the Board of Economic Warfare
1942-47	Editor of <u>World Economics</u> , the Bulletin of the Institute of World Economics
1943-45	Economic advisor to the Foreign Economic Administration
1945-52	Advisor to the Office of International Trade of the Department of Commerce
1946-49	Advisor to the U.S. delegation to the United Nations
1955-58	Research consultant at The New School
1961-70	Associate in the Columbia University Seminar on Labor
