DESCRIPTION:

The collection is composed of 163 documents, letters and papers relating to the ecclesiastical, political and social history of Mexico from 1649 to 1858. A large group of ecclestical material is dated 1772 while most of the secular papers fall in the early part of the 19th century. Of these documents 144 originated from archepiscopal authority and bear the signatures or seals of Manuel Barrientos (Vicar General and acting Archbishop), Andres Martinez Campillo (Canon of the Metropolitan Parish Church), Francesco Antonio Lorenzana (24th archbishop of Mexico) etc. These include about 67 dispensations in cases of marriage to avoid publishing the banns, to set aside degrees of consanguinity and affinity, etc.; a chronological list of the 31 archbishops of Mexico from 1527 to 1921; wills and settlement of estates. Among the material of less ecclesiastical nature there are letters and offical communications relating to revolutionary leaders (1811-1886) reports from viceregal archives, tax assessments, etc.
