His correspondence contains letters from many prominent public administrators, historians, jurists, and politicians, including among many others Charles Beard, Edward Mead Earle, Felix Frankfurter, Herbert H. Lehman, and Franklin Delano Roosevelt, and Harry S. Truman.
