DESCRIPTION:  
Correspondence, manuscripts, and drawings of Augustus John Cuthbert Hare, 1834-1903, artist and author of many travel books and memoirs, and of his family. His letters concern the writing and publishing of his books and his many social and friendly relationships. There are the autograph manuscripts of the announcement of his book Shropshire and of his autobiographical essay "The Hare with Many Friends", as well as five original pencil and wash drawings of buildings in France, Germany, and Switzerland used as illustrations in his popular travel books. There are also several devotional manuscripts by other members of the Hare family.
