## DESCRIPTION:

Correspondence, memoranda, and financial and legal papers of Levi Hollingsworth Wood, 1874 - 1956 (Columbia L.L.B. 1899) as president of the National Urban League. The papers chronicle Wood's role in the early history of the league (there are substantial gaps for the years 1921 - 1939.) Among the major correspondents are Mary McLeod Bethune, Chester Bowles, Pearl S. Buck, Anna Lord Strauss and Booker T. Washington.
