Papers of Mikhail M. Fedorov (1858-1945), a leader of the Kadet Party in Russia, who was very active in emigre social and political life in Paris in the 1920s and 1930s. The collections, which consists of correspondence, manuscripts, documents, subject fixes, and printed materials, concerns emigre educational and political groups in Europe. Most of the collection deals with the Central Committee to Secure Higher Education for Russian Youth Abroad (Tsentral'nyi Komitet po Obezpecheniiu Vysshago Obrazovaniia Russkomu Iunishestvu za Granitsei), which Fedorov headed. There are also materials on the Union of Russian Students in France (Soiuz Russkikh Studentov vo Frantsii), for 1921-22; the Russian National Committee (Russkii Natsional'nyi Komitet), of which Fedorov was vice-president; the journal Bor'ba za Rossiiu, which he edited; and the Commission to Coordinate the Activity of Russian Organizations Aiding the Unemployed (Komissiia po Soglasovaniiu Deiatel'nosti Russkikh Organizatsii, Okazyvaiushchikh Pomoshch' Bezrabotnym), which he chaired. Cataloged correspondents in the collection include Aleksandr Kizevetter, Semen Frank, Sergei Rakhmanînov, and Petr Struve.
