DESCRIPTION:

Memoirs of Evlogii (1868-1946), Metropolitan of the Russian Orthodox Church in the emigration, born Vasilii Georgievskii. In Russia, Evlogii served as Bishop of Lublin, Archbishop of Kholm, and Archbishop of Volynia. His memoirs cover from his childhood to the 1930s. They were published, in a somewhat abridged form, as Put' moei zhizni (Paris, 1947). This typescript version (986p.) includes many handwritten corrections and annotations by Evlogii. Also included with the memoirs are copies of reviews of the book.
