DESCRIPTION:

Manuscript and typescript memoirs on various subjects by Mikhail A. Golubov (1893-), an officer in Cossack units of the Imperial and White armies, who emigrated to Turkey, then Greece, and finally settled in Austria. The memoirs describe Saratov in 1917, the Crimea in 1920, refugee camps in Turkey in 1920-1, Vienna during World War II, the repatriation of Cossacks at Lienz in 1945, and displaced persons camps after World War II.
