DESCRIPTION:

Three typescripts by Garal'd K. Graf ( - ), an officer in the Russian Imperial Navy, who was later active in the emigré monarchist movement headed by the Grand Duke Kirill Vladimirovich. One typescript, entitled "Imperator bez trona: Zapiski nachal'nika kantseliarii (nabliudeniia i mysli)" (596 p.), describes the history of the Monarchist movement. The other two manuscripts deal with the Imperial Navy. One is entitled "Na baltiiskom flote: Period vozrozhdeniia flota posle Iaponskoi voiny, s 1906 g. do 1914 g." (359 p., 2 drafts); the other is entitled "Rusksii flot: Materialy dlia izucheniiia Ruskskoi voenno-morskoi frazeologii" (203 p.). It contains a glossary of naval terms.
