Manuscript and typescript memoirs (in all ca. 600p.) of Wasilii A. Kamenskii (1891-1974), member of the Imperial Corps of Pages before World War I and officer in the Jaeger Life Guard Regiment (Leib-Gvardii Egerskii Polk) during the war. The memoirs deal chiefly with his military education, the imperial court, his service during World War I, his service as General Petr Wrangel's diplomatic courier in 1921-24, and the emigration in France. Part of the manuscripts on World War I consists of copies of his diary. Some hand-drawn maps and photographs are included with the memoirs. Also included are six copies of the bulletin of the organization of veterans of the Jaeger Regiment.
