DESCRIPTION:	

Papers of Sergei M. Kravchinskii (1852-1895), a revolutionary novelist who wrote under the name Sergei Stepniak. Among his works was Podpol'naia Rossiia. The papers consist primarily of letters from Kravchinskii to his wife, Fanni; these are in a numbered sequence, which does not appear to be fully chronological, and some are incomplete. There are also 3 items from Petr Kropotkin and 1 from Eduard Bernstein, and other correspondence. There is a manuscript by Kravchinskii in memory of Mykhailo Drahomaniv, and photographs of Kravchinskii and of his wife.
