Kuz'mina-Karavaeva Diary on MICROFILM

DESCRIPTION: Memoirs of Dmitrii D. Kuz'min-Karavaev(1891-) and the diary of his wife, Ol'ga A.(-). Kuz'min-Karavaev was an officer in the White Army who emigrated to Finland and later spent 1945-1955 in Soviet prison camps. The collection includes a three-part typescript copy of a diary by Kuz'mina-Karavaeva concerning the arrest of her husband by the Soviets and her years spent in Finland awaiting his return(1945-1954). Kuz'min-Karavaev's memoirs include a four-part typescript memoir concerning his experiences as a prisoner in Soviet prison camps, a typescript memoir about his return to Finland, and memoirs on his childhood and Russian military education.
