DESCRIPTION: Correspondence, manuscripts, photographs, subject files, and printed materials of Mikhail V. Bernatskii (1876-ca. 1945?), who was an important financial official in both the 1917 Provisional Government and in the White government of south Russia in 1919-20. Cataloged correspondence consists of letters by Petr Struve. There are Bernatskii's memoirs of 1917, and copies of several publications by him. Subject files concern: the finances of the Provisional Government; of the Whites in the south and in Siberia and the Far East; and the settlement of White army veterans in European countries in the 1920s.
