DESCRIPTION:

Papers of Nikolai E. Markov (1866-1945), consisting of correspondence, a brief biography (apparently by his nephew), and printed materials. Markov was a leader of the Union of the Russian People (Soiuz Russkogo Naroda) and representative to the Russian State Duma. In the emigration he continued his monarchist and anti-Semitic activities, edited the journal Dvuglavyi Orel and Mirovaia Sluzhba. Correspondence in this collection consists of letters to a nephew named Seva. Printed materials include issues of Mirovaia Sluzhba (1936-38), and two books by Markov: Voiny temnykh sil (Paris, 1928), and Otrechennye dni revral'skoi revoliutsii 1917 goda (Harbin, 1938).
