a close associate of Tsars Alexander III and Nicholas II. Meshcherskii edited for many years the right-wing periodical Grazhdanin. Included are 67 letters and telegrams by Alexander III from 1863-1872; 11 letters, notes, and telegrams, by Alexander's older brother Nikolai (d. 1865); 65 letters and notes, some copies, by Nicholas II, from 1902-1913; a drawing and notes by Alexander III; and drafts of letters by Meshcherskii. Also included is a group of letters in different hands hitherto identified as having been written by Nikolai, Duke of Leuchtenberg, to Meshcherskii.
