DESCRIPTION: Papers of Nikolai D. Nelidov(-), an officer in the White Army who emigrated to Paris after the Civil War. The collection consists of correspondence, manuscripts, memoranda, and printed materials. Correspondence, mostly from the Soiuz natsional'nogo osvobozhdeniia(Union for National Liberation) and the Sovet ob"edineniia russkoi molodezhi(Council of United Russian Youth), concerns the establishment of a united monarchist movement in the 1920s. Manuscripts and memoranda describe the state of the monarchist movement in the emigration. Printed materials consist of monarchist pamphlets and circulars, and also contain printed directives dated 1919 from the commander of the Prishibskaia, Gal'bshtadskaia and Graderfel'skaia volosts.
