**DESCRIPTION:** 

Correspondence, manuscripts, and printed materials of Konstantin N. Nikolaev (1884-1965), who acted as legal consultant for the Russian Orthodox Church in Poland until 1933. Later in the United States he became president of the Ob"edinenie Russkikh Iuristov Byvshikh D.P. v Amerike (Union of Russian Jurists (Former Displaced Persons) in America). Correspondence mostly concerns the Ob"edinenie in the 1950s. One of the manuscripts by Nikolaev is entitled, "Ukrainsko-pol'skie otnosheniia vo vremia sovetsko-pol'skoi voiny 1920-1921 gg." Nikolaev's memoirs largely concern his activities as legal consultant to the Orthodox Church in Poland. Printed materials deal mostly with the Ob"edinenie.
