DESCRIPTI OI	Manuscripts and printed materials of Konstantin N. Nikolaev (1889-1963), an Imperial and White army officer who served during World War II in the Russkii Okhrannyi Korpus (Russian Defense Corps) in Yugoslavia and was later a displaced person in Austria. Nikolaev's memoirs, "Moi zhiznennyi put,'" discuss his service in the White army, the Russian Defense Corps, and the camp in Kellerberg, Austria after World War II. Another manuscript is entitled, "Deistviia Russkago Okhrannago Korpusa v Serbii, 1941-45 gg."  Manuscripts and memoirs by others largely concern General Lavr Kornilov. There is a subject file on the Sodruzhestvo Lients (Lienz Printed materials include a mimeographed pamphlet, "Kratkii obzor zhizni i deiatel'nosti russkoi gruppy v lagere Kellerberg."
