A manuscript and document of Nikolai S. Polushkin (1876-196?), former official of the Imperial Ministry of Foreign Affairs and author of Spiski rossiiskim dvorianskim rodam(1920). Polushkin's typescript, Rossiiskii Rodoslovnyi Sbornik (205p. with 10-page supplement) is a survey of the Russian nobility throughout the Russian Empire. It primarily deals with noble families from the 17th-19th centuries, but also traces some families back to Riurik. The manuscript is indexed. The document is a table listing the Imperial Foreign Ministry staff in Europe from 1878 to 1917.
