DESCRIPTION: The collection consists of two manuscripts by Major-General Fedor P. Rerberg (i.e. Roehrberg), (1868-1928), entitled Istoricheskie tainy velikikh pobed i neob'iasnimykh porazhenii. Zapiski uchastnika Russko-Japonskoi voiny 1904-1905 gg. (Alexandria, Egypt, 1925) and Zapiski, vospominania, kritika, melkia stat'i. Tom VIII.
