DESCRIPTION: This small collection consists primarily of private papers belonging to General Ivan P. Romanovskii (1877- 1920), General Denikin's Chief of Staff from 1918-1920 who was assassinated in Constantinople on 23 March 1920. Included are photocopies of his school records, his marriage certificate and of three letters to his widow from Vladimir Bek and Aleksei A. von Lampe, as well as biographical information assembled by his daughter Irina I. Malina. In addition there are original certificates of merit and cossack village council decrees honoring Romanovskii, several letters, two military decrees signed by General Denikin, and two maps tracing the southern front.
