DESCRIPTION: The manuscripts of Ivan Ivanovich and Valentyna Pavlovna Shali, husband and wife, originally from Khar'kov and since World War II residents in France. Ivan I. Shali ( - ), a veterinarian by profession, experienced first hand, between 1930 and 1940, life in Siberian prison camps. The collection contains his memoirs, written in Russian, from that period. His wife, Valentyna P. Shali (1896- ), an economist, is represented in the collection by a published anthology of Ukrainian folk tales in French translation and by an unpublished Ukrainian manuscript on the political and economic history of modern-day Eastern Europe.
