Correspondence and financial and organizational records of Sergei F. Shtern (1887-~~1952~~) relating to the Russian emigre aid society in France, Obshchestvo "Bystraia Pomoshch'" (the "Prompt Assistance" Society). Shtern, who was the treasurer and vice-president of the Society, was active in emigre social efforts. Most of the materials, including correspondence from aid petitioners or recipients, of other organizations, and financial records, reports, and receipts, date from 1945-47.
