DESCRIPTION.

Correspondence, manuscripts, a document, and photographs of Aleksei I. Skrylov (1894-), Imperial and White army officer. The correspondence dates from the 1950's to the 1970's and concerns emigre Cossack affairs as well as the career of Skrylov's son, Valerian. There are essays on the Kuban Cossacks, political events in 1964 and on the Cossack dictionary Skrylov was compiling. There is a photocopy of a 1948 certificate Skrylov received from the "Soiuz pervago kubanskago pokhoda" in Munich. The cataloged photograph is of General Lavr Kornilov in 1916, shortly before his escape from a military hospital in Köszég, Hungary, and there are photographs of both Skrylov and his son.
