DESCRIPTION: Correspondence, manuscripts, photographs and printed materials of Sergei A. Toporkov (1880-), Imperial and White Army officer. Much of the collection consists of materials Toporkov collected and used for a three-volume history of the Fifth Hussar Regiment (Piatyi gusarskii aleksandriiskii polk), of which he had been a member. There are also materials concerning members of the regiment who emigrated after the 1917 Revolution. The correspondence (1919-1952) includes letters to and from members of several emigre military organizations. The manuscripts include essays and memoirs about the regiment during World War I and the Civil War (including several by Toporkov himself) as well as Toporkov's three-volume history of his regiment. There are notes and citations concerning the history of the regiment from the eighteenth century through 1929, the regiment museum, individual members of the regiment, regiment celebrations (1926-1935), the Court of Honor, and regiment financial affairs (1925-1948). Among the printed materials are clippings and materials relating to a number of emigre organizations.
