DESCRIPTION:
Correspondence, manuscripts, documents, photographs and printed materials of Pavel P. Tutkovskii (1889-1959), lawyer, writer, and composer. There is some personal and business correspondence. The collection consists primarily of manuscripts by Tutkovskii, including poems, short stories, an historical novel, and music compositions. There is also a short biography of Tutkovskii by his wife, Ekaterina Konstantinovna. Also included are Tutkovskii's personal documents, and several photographs. Printed materials include concert programs, flyers, and reviews, and novels by Tutkovskii, such as Orden novykh liudei and Deti komety.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Born in Kiev, Tutkovskii became first violinist for the Mariiskaia Opera. In 1915 he graduated with a degree in law from Moscow University. Tutkovskii emigrated to Yugoslavia after 1921, to France in 1928, and finally to America in 1955. His first book, Gibel' rossiiskoi kommuny, was followed by several novels, short stories, poems and basni. The author died in California in 1959.
