DESCRIPTION:

Correspondence, manuscripts, printed materials and photographs of Aleksandr A. Vetlits (1882-1972?), a well established horsebreeder in pre-revolutionary Russia who later emigrated to Yugoslavia. The correspondence includes letter drafts by Vetlits, and letters from R. Shubovich. The collection consists primarily of Vetlits' manuscripts pertaining to horsebreeding and horseracing in Russia, Yugoslavia, the First and Second World Wars, and the 1917 revolution in Russia. Some of the manuscripts describe Vetlits' childhood and family, and his memoirs are included in the form of a letter. The printed materials consist of clippings of articles by Vetlits.
