DESCRIPTION:

Corrospondence, manuscripts, photographs, and printed materials of Evgenia M. (1873- ) and Pavel A. Briunelli ( -1949). She was an educator in Russia, he a lawyer and later a military historian. The bulk of the collection consists of Mrs. Briunelli's 35 diaries, covering the years 1891-1956. The correspondence consists of letters from Mrs. Briunelli's sister in Leningrad from 1922 to the early 1940's. Pavel Briunelli's memoirs are on the emigration in France in the 1920's and 1930's. The printed materials are made up largely of his writings.
