N: Papers of Maksim M. Vinaver (1862-1926). Vinaver was a lawyer and a leading Russian liberal; he was a founder of the Constitutional Democrat (Kadet) Party, and a delegate to the first Russian State Duma. In the emigration he settled in Paris and edited the weekly <u>Zveno</u>.

These papers consist of correspondence, manuscripts, and printed materials. The correspondence consists of typed copies of letters sent by Vinaver and Ivan Petrunkevich to each other. Manuscripts include a Dume speech by Vinaver on the Bialystok pogrom of 1906 and two items on Russian politics by him. There is also an essay by Petr Iurenev on the Vinaver-Petrunkevich correspondence. Printed materials include bound copies of Zveno for 1926-28, and six books by or about Vinaver.
