Manuscripts, chiefly memoirs, of Aleksandr V. Zen'kovskii (1878-1968?), author of Pravda o Stolypine (1956) and brother of Orthodox priest Vasilii Zen'kovskii. Aleksandr Zen'kovskii worked in the Kiev zemstvo from 1903, and was also associated with Petr Stolypin. After the Civil War, he lived in various European countries and finally settled in the United States. These manuscripts discuss particularly Petr Stolypin; the Kiev zemstvo; the 1917 revolution; the Ukraine in 1918, including a zemstvo congress in Kiev; and the Civil War in 1919-20, when Zen'kovskii worked provisioning the White army and and also civilians in the Crimea.
