**DESCRIPTION:** 

Correspondence, manuscripts, photographs, subject files, and printed materials of Petr L. Bark (1869-1937). Bark entered the service of the Russian Imperial government in 1892, and in 1914-17 was the last Finance Minister of the Empire. After the 1917 revolution he lived in England, where he became managing director of the Anglo-International Bank, and was knighted in 1935. Cataloged materials in this collection include letters from Metropolitan Evlogii, Boris Bakhmeteff, and Petr Struve, and Bark's extensive memoirs. Much of the correspondence concerns the Civil War and attempts to gain Allied support for the White forces, and also Bark's career as an English banker in the 1930s. Subject files concern White governments in south Russia, and Bark's life. There are also two photographs of Bark.
