DESCRIPTION: Papers of Iurii A. Cheremshanskii (-), member of the Guards Cavalry Regiment at the time of the Revolution, including correspondence, manuscripts, photographs, and printed materials. Most of the collection relates either to the role of the Cossacks in the Revolution and Civil War or to the affairs of the Russian emigre community in the Far East. The largest single item is a memoir of his childhood and youth by Vladimir Nikolaevich Gaevskii (1862-1943), the son of landowners in Voronezh gubernia. There are two memoirs of the Cossacks' activities during the revolutionary period, one by Cheremshanskii himself, the other by I.N. Oprits. Substantial subject files are devoted to the troubled affairs of the principal administrative body of the Shanghai Russian emigre community, the Russkii Emigrantskii Komitet, in 1939-1941. Other files are devoted to Ataman Grigorii Semenov and to emigre political organizations, the Brotherhood of Russian Truth (Bratstvo Russkoi Pravdy) and Russian fascists.

There is a single catalogued item, a 1937 letter from Vladimir Burtsev to Cheremshanskii proposing the creation of an anti-GPU organization.
