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of the Publications of the Modern Language Association of America.

This bibliography grew out of research undertaken in 1957 for a critical analysis of American scholarship on East Central Europe from 1945 through 1957. This paper, which is published in this book, was presented at a conference at Columbia University on "The American Concern with East Central Europe." The bibliographical research and analysis undertaken for that article were so considerable that I decided to make the collection complete and to publish it, particularly since this step will provide experience for another work in progress, an annotated bibliography of American scholarship on Russia and East Central Europe since 1945. I hope this will be a useful tool for both scholars and teachers and that it will serve as a measure of the achievements and shortcomings of the interest in and research upon this critical area by Americans since World War II.

I have been generously assisted by the Indiana University Research Committee, whose support I gratefully acknowledge. The burden of much of the collecting and checking was cheerfully and skillfully undertaken by Joseph Backor, Matthew Downey, Janet Hawley, and Edward O'Day. My wife, in the midst of all her other duties, completed the index.
