of the chapter called "The Army in Action") to its contribution to Egyptian civil society, he explores the political roles of the military forces, he concludes, to pose: Roman authority (then, to provide security), patterns of veterans recruitment, punishment, legal setting, the economic role of the army, and the activities of soldiers. In the two useful appendices, the second offers a handy collection of the names of both Egyptian Akhet signs + forcefully argues many common views, particularly those that see soldiers as locally recognized and notorious as local "big men." Altogether a useful volume for anyone interested in the social role of the army, though the analysis of fighting and its consequences sometimes casts a gulf of unreality over the whole.
