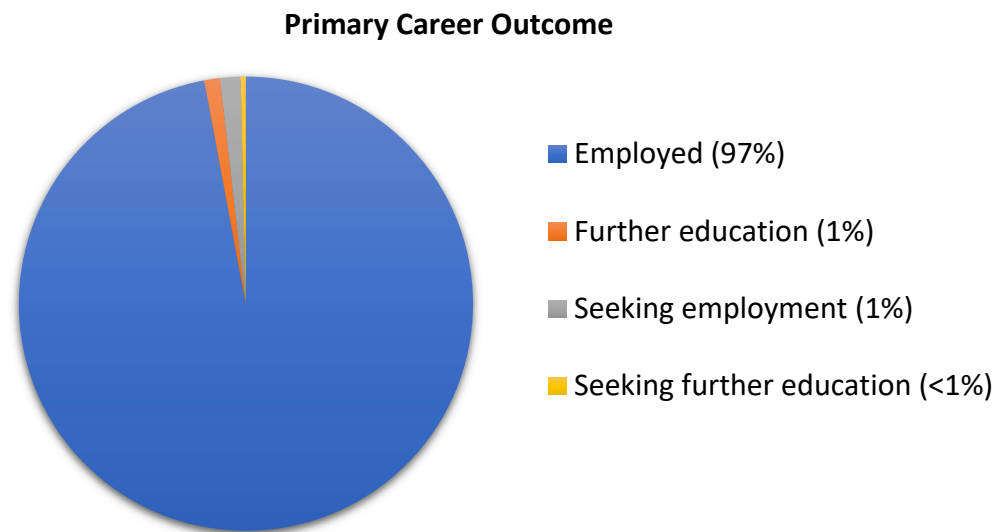


## 2021 Master of Science in Social Work Degree Recipients Career Outcomes

*Source:* Data collected within the first year post-graduation via a career survey, self-reports, and web searches (Linked-In profiles, employer web sites, etc.). Career outcomes were identified for 273 out of the 489 students who received the Master of Science in Social Work degree in 2021, yielding a knowledge rate of 56%.

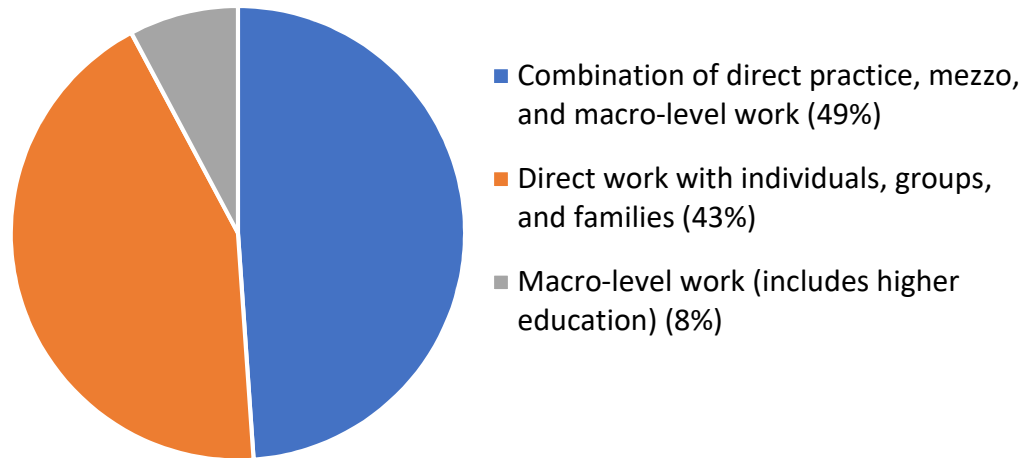


**The annual median salary** reported by respondents to a spring 2022 survey of alumni who graduated from the MS in Social Work program in 2021 was \$62,000 for full-time employment in the US. The average was \$62,574. Salaries ranged from \$48,000 to \$100,000, with an interquartile range of \$55,000 to \$65,000. Additional benefits/compensation mentioned by CSSW graduates included: professional development/education funds, medical and life insurance, retirement contribution, student loan repayment, signing and year-end bonuses, reimbursement for clinical supervision expenses, and relocation reimbursement.

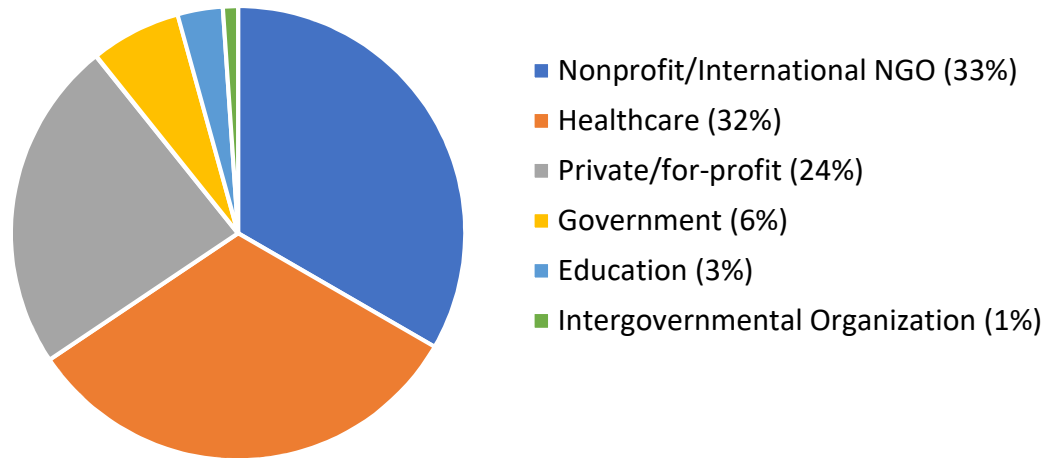

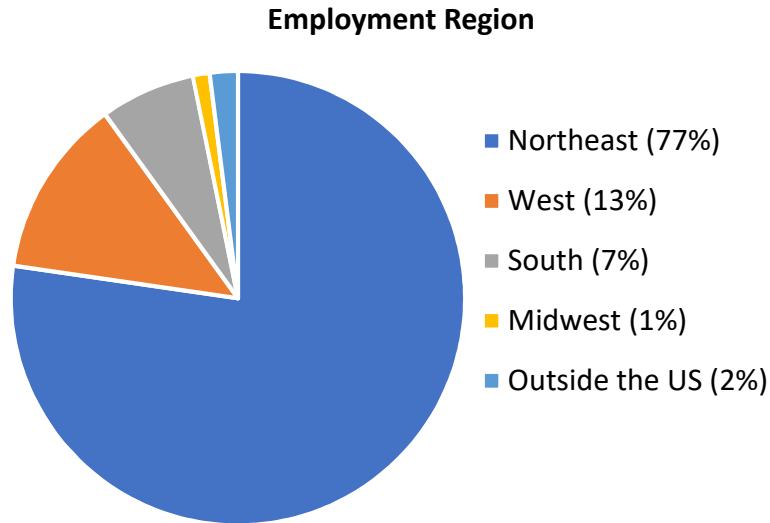
